Pu'ukohola Heiau

Further north the ancestral temples of the deities, Lono, Ku, Kane and Kanaloa offer a graduated view of Heiau, stone temples above and below sea level. Built to capture stellar reflections that fulfill prophecy. Between the first and second temples are the grounds of the sanctuary, Pelekane that naturally evolve and adapt to suit the times. A reminder that fire and water may disagree in order to agree. Amidst the turmoil of suffering there is peace.
